**Community Resources:** Serving as a central early childhood resource hub and point for health professionals, service leaders, educators, parents, and caregivers.

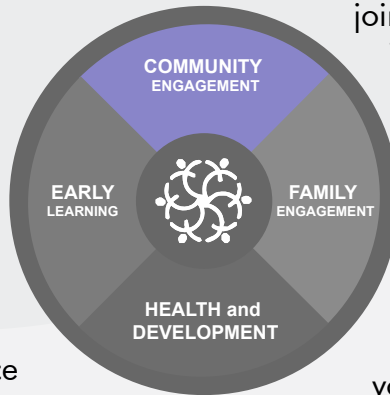
**Coordinated Intake:** Connecting families to home visiting programs and high-quality preschool through a single point of contact.
